It has been shown that in selecting a spouse who happens to be related the relationship is traced back through their mothers' side (5); their fathers' side (6); either one or the other (13).

This is an indication of the importance given to both sides, as proper to a bilateral system.

7 children (3 M & 4 f.) Except for a female and one bachelor the rest were Umatas spouses (3 related). All 7 reside in UMATAS.
